#### REPORT ON CATARACT CAMP

### **Sponsors: Cataracts Are Curable – The Gambian Project**

This Report is submitted in fulfillment of our commitment between the **Cataracts Are Curable** and the staff of the Bansang Hospital Vision Centre. The report is submitted after successfully operating 75 Gambians whose operation fees were paid in full by Cataracts Are Curable at Bansang Hospital the Gambia, in the Central River Region (CRR).

After conducting community sensitization and outreach screenings in different communities, patients with cataracts that needed surgical intervention were identified and proper eye examination done to fulfill the criteria to undergo cataract extraction.

Patients were given lab forms to check their blood glucose level (BM) in order to rule out diabetes mellitus, this is routine in our pre-operative assessment. Blood pressure checked to rule out hypertension. Those found to be hypertensive were referred to get treatment (anti-hypertensive) and appointments given to them to follow up.

Intra-ocular pressure was checked to rule out glaucoma. Patients with glaucoma were referred to SZRECC at Kanifing for management of both cataract extraction and glaucoma surgery (trabeculectomy).

The cataract camp kicked off on the 29<sup>th</sup> of November 2021. The patient's personal mobile numbers were taken to enable us to contact them. The team decided to conduct the camp on 8 different dates with intervals that is conducive for both the patients and the team. With the COVID pandemic we did not over-crowd during surgery.

The 75 patients who had their surgeries paid for by **Cataracts Are Curable** were operated from 29<sup>th</sup> of November 2021 to 4<sup>th</sup> of January 2022.

The 29<sup>th</sup> November 2021. A total of 14 patients were operated upon: 10 males, 4 females.

The  $8^{th}$  of November. A total of 14 patients were operated upon : 11 males, 3 females.

On the 30<sup>th</sup> November, total of 13 patients were operated upon.

On the  $14^{\text{th}}$  of December 2021 a total of 12 patients had their cataracts operated upon.

20<sup>th</sup> December 2021 a total of 12 patients got their cataracts extracted: 5 male, 7 female.

On the 23<sup>rd</sup> of December 2021 8 patients were operated upon:4 males, 4 females.

The 4<sup>th</sup> of January 2022, which was the last day of free surgery camp a total of 7 patients were operated upon: 2 males and 5 females had their cataracts extracted.

All 75 patients, whose operation fees were paid by **Cataracts Are Curable**, were discharge the following day after surgery. All patients had undergone post-operative examination; they have different visual expectations, examination under the slit lamp done. Appointments were given to all of them with post-operative medications and health education done as to the DOs and DONTs.

In total 39 females and 36 males had been operated and visions restored.

The biggest risks factor for cataract formation is aging. We still have patients that are blind because of cataract in our communities, as the population ages we expect more. The free camp also revealed that a lot of patients had co-existing medical conditions like diabetes and glaucoma that needed treatment.

Most of the people blind from cataract are farmers who find it difficult to afford surgery fees or are not aware that cataracts are operated in Bansang hospital.

The camp also serves to alleviate fear of surgery, some patients were comfortable when many patients were being arranged for the surgery.

Cataract is the most common and fortunately one of the most remedied. Operating a large number will go a long way to reduce the number of cataract blindness.

"One of the basic human rights is the right to see".

From the patients who had their vision restored through the free surgeries, they are all grateful for the generosity by paying for their cataract operations.

From the team of Bansang hospital vision centre staff who conducted the camp, through the National Eye Health Programme. We want to thank the sponsors of the 75 Gambians who had their cataracts operated for putting smiles on their faces. Efficient surgery can reduce the large number of people being blind from cataract.


