REPORT ON CATARACT CAMP

Brikama Ba Health Centre

July – August 2022

Sponsors: Cataracts Are Curable – The Gambian Project

The surgical team from Bansang General Hospital held 3 cataract camps at CRR. The camps were held at Brikama Ba Health Centre on the following dates: 16/7/2022, 21/7/22, 28/7/22 and 8/8/22.

A total of 75 cataract patients had their vision restored through small incision cataract surgery which was fully paid for by **Cataracts Are curable** – **The Gambian Project**.

The camp commenced on the 16th of July 2022. On this day 23 patients were operated on: 10 females, 13 males. The second day 25 cataract operations were carried out: 15 females and 10 males had their surgeries done and 20 operations were done on the third day, 14 females and 6 males.

All these patients were operated by small incision cataract surgery and 72 of them had (IOL) posterior capsule implants. Three were aphakic meaning without Intraocular lens because they had vitreous loss during surgery.

Our team comprises of a Principal Ophthalmic Medical Assistant (POMA), the cataract surgeon, an Ophthalmic Medical Assistant (OMA), two Community Ophthalmic Nurses one from Brikama Ba and the other from Bansang Secondary Eye Unit, two Community Nurse Attendants, a driver and an orderly from

Brikama Ba and two volunteer village health workers from Brikama Ba and Boiram.

This provision of free cataract surgeries to poor and underprivileged population in the CRR, Brikama Ba and the surrounding villages provides them access to affordable eye care services. It also creates awareness of the eye care services and acceptance of the services.

All the patients operated upon were given post operative drugs and health educated on their post operative management. They were all satisfied with a good vision after the surgery.

CHALLENGES AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The biggest challenge that we had in previous camps were human resources but this last camp was very different with the participation and the involvement of the community members. The village health centre worker at Boiram and Brikama Ba were volunteers throughout the three day camp, an orderly from Brikama Ba health centre helped in crowd control and making sure the operation site is kept clean all the time. We would consider doing it again if possible but not during the rainy season.

Some patients who were previously booked for the camp did not turn up and reasons from some are: they are busy on farming. The good thing was some patients who came in late were assessed and fit for surgery, so they got registered. That's the reason why there were a lot of changes in the list that was sent and those that got operated.

We really need I-CARE to rule out glaucoma. This is the most need working tool. The team will need it for us to provide the best possible case selection for camps.

The team will also need a Bm machine to check blood glucose level to rule diabetes mellitus.
