



ESSAU DISTRICT HOSPITAL CATARACT CAMP 2023

Essau District Hospital is located in Essau village in Lower Niumi District,

in the North Bank Region-West. It was established in 1948 with a catchment area population of 43,686 inhabitants (GBOS: 2013). The hospital is very important for the people of this region because it is the only referral hospital in the region for all the surrounding Major and Minor Health Centres in the region. The Essau District Hospital Eye unit was established in 1996 and since then continue to provide a comprehensive eye service to the people of the region and beyond.

Essau District Hospital, through the NEHP, received funds from Cataract Are Curable (CAC) for the implementation of cataract camp for seventy (70) peoples. The camp was conducted in EDH from the 18th of July to the 23rd of August 2023. It was an implementation of a community screening done in March 2023 in the satellite villages of EDH.

Seventy cases were successfully operated from Lower Niumi, Upper Niumi, Jokadou and beyond. The camp came at a time when majority of the beneficiaries were actively engaged in farming, nonetheless the cataract camp went on successfully.

The challenges encountered includes patient's failure to report on the selected dates as a result of either lack of escorts as most of them are busy on the farm or heavy rains. Mobility is a major problem affecting the delivery of comprehensive eye services in the region.

The personnel involved in the implementation of the cataract camp were;

A total of seventy (70) people benefited from the free eye surgeries sponsored by CAC. Thirty-three (33) of the seventy (70) cases operated were males while the rest were

females. Thirty-two (32) of the thirty-three (33) males were cataract patients.

Of the females operated, thirty (30) were cataract patients who had a successful SICS+PC-IOL and one of the cases was aphakic (no lens in the eye). Six females were operated on for pterygium (a growth over the eye) and one for chalazion (a cyst in the eye).. The camp was done in batches due to the rainy season coupled with an ongoing renovation in the hospital with limited space to accommodate a large number at a go. All the patients had an excellent post-operative management with free medications. Upon discharge they were health educated on the correct use of the medications and care of the eye with emphasis on good hygiene.

The beneficiaries are very happy and pray for the sponsors CAC and partners for restoring their sight. Cataract still remains to be a huge problem in rural setting. Therefore, there is need for more concerted effort in other to remedy the backlog of cataracts in the rural community. Thanks to CAC for really meaning cataracts are curable by making sure cataracts are identified wherever they are and cured free of charge.
